

8:00 am ARRIVAL for Registration at Luna Park Big Face

YOC Registration Volunteers will walk each school to the 'Big Top' front foyer area, which is our designated Registration Tables.

Each school teacher will be assigned a QR Code for ease of registration. Once registered your school will receive a wristband for each of your students to wear. This will allow for clear event identification

HEALTH AND SAFETY BRIEFING

FOR VISITING EDUCATIONAL PARTIES

Whilst on site teachers and accompanying adults are responsible for their students at ALL times (required 1:20).

Schools are responsible for any first aid that students may require and MUST bring a first aid kit. Youth Ocean Carnival (YOC) will have a first aid officer on site at Luna Park Sydney. If an incident occurs please find the Youth Ocean Carnival first aid officer.

A lead teacher needs to be appointed and acknowledged on the booking form. This member of staff is responsible for explaining all health and safety matters regarding your visit to ALL supervising adults.

ON ARRIVAL REGISTRATION

Registration starts at 8.00am on June 5th 2024. Please intend to arrive no later than 15 minutes before the start of the program at 9:00am. There will be YOC Volunteer staff ready to assist upon your arrival for entry into Luna Park, registration and access to the Big Top.

Please ensure students and staff ONLY bring small sized backpacks as there is limited space for storage during the event. Students can bring their own recess and lunch but may be able to purchase limited snacks. Luna Park will have one cafe open where students can purchase snacks during the break time. TRANSPORT INFORMATION

Luna Park is easily accessible through several forms of transport. Plan your trip with the trip planner or take a look at the options below.

LUNA PARK SYDNEY LOCATION:

1 Olympic Dr, Milsons Point NSW 2061

BY PRIVATE BUS/COACH

If you are arriving by private bus/coach Luna Park Sydney have requested that all buses line up on Albert Street South. Access for buses/ coaches is from Kirribilli down Broughton St which loops onto Olympic Drive. A YOC Transport coordinator will be available to assist you with your arrival and we will provide contact details on the 29th May 2024 - (7 Days out from event)



BY BUS

Sydney state transit bus routes frequently pass nearby North Sydney Station and/or terminate at Milsons Point (just a five minute stroll from Luna Park Sydney), they are a fast, easy and picturesque way to get here.

ARRIVAL BY TRAIN MILSONS POINT STATION

Milsons Point station is the closest train station to Luna Park Sydney. Travelling north, Milsons Point Station is the first stop after Wynyard station in the CBD. Travelling south it is immediately after North Sydney Station. Milsons Point Station can be found on both the 'T1 North Shore & Western Line' and 'T9 Northern Line'. From the station Luna Park Sydney is a 10 minute stroll downhill towards the water and location of Luna Park Sydney
